**LEGAL NOTICE

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING**

Notice and warning is hereby given to the legal voters of the Town of Sterling and those property owners qualified to vote in Town Meetings pursuant to Section 7-6 of the Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) that a special Town Meeting will be commenced on Thursday, October 16, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. in Conference Room #15 of the Sterling Town Hall, 1183 Plainfield Pike, Oneco, CT, to consider and act upon the following questions:

1. Shall the Town approve the creation of the *Road Resurfacing Capital Account* that would be used specifically for the purpose of resurfacing roads & to be funded from the *General Fund Balance*?
2. Shall the Town approve the following amounts in Capital Transfers from the *General Fund Balance*:
 - a. \$50,000.00 to the *Revaluation Capital Account*?
 - b. \$500,000.00 to the *Facilities Maintenance Capital Account*?
 - c. \$100,000.00 to the *Equipment Capital Account*?
 - d. \$200,000.00 to the *Buses and Vans Capital Account*?
 - e. \$75,000.00 to the *IT-Hardware Capital Account*?
 - f. \$500,000.00 to the *Road Resurfacing Capital Account*?

Copies of all of the proposed items referenced above are available for review on the Town's website and at the Sterling Town Hall, Town Clerk's office, during normal business hours.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CAPITAL ACCOUNT FOR ROAD RESURFACING

SECTION 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a dedicated capital account within the Town of Sterling's financial system for the purpose of funding road resurfacing projects, thereby ensuring long-term infrastructure integrity and prudent fiscal planning. This account will be overseen by the Sterling Board of Finance.

SECTION 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF CAPITAL ACCOUNT

There is hereby established a capital account titled the **"Road Resurfacing Capital Account"** (hereinafter, "the Account") within the Town of Sterling's municipal fund structure.

SECTION 3. USE OF FUNDS

Funds deposited in the Road Resurfacing Capital Account shall be used exclusively for the following purposes:

- Planning, engineering, resurfacing, or repaving of existing public roads within the Town of Sterling.
- Costs of materials, labor, and equipment directly related to resurfacing work.

SECTION 4. FUNDING SOURCES

Funding for the Road Resurfacing Capital Account may include, but is not limited to:

- Annual budget appropriations approved by Town Meeting.
- Transfers from other municipal accounts, as approved by the Board of Finance and Town Meeting.
- Any other funds legally designated for this purpose.

SECTION 5. MANAGEMENT AND OVERSIGHT

The Sterling Board of Finance shall have full oversight authority over the Road Resurfacing Capital Account, including:

- Reviewing and approving all expenditures from the Account.
- Recommending annual funding levels during the town's budget process.
- Ensuring that all use of funds complies with the scope and purpose outlined in this ordinance.

No funds shall be expended from the Account without prior approval from the Board of Finance. The Town Treasurer shall be responsible for the investment and management of the Account, subject to direction of the Board of Finance.

SECTION 6. AMENDMENT AND DISSOLUTION

This ordinance may be amended or repealed by a majority vote at a duly called Town Meeting. Upon dissolution of the Account, any remaining funds shall revert to the Town's General Fund unless otherwise directed by vote of the Town Meeting.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication in a newspaper having circulation within the Town of Sterling, in accordance with applicable law.


