

The Special Town Meeting of September 4, 2025, was called to order at 6:30 pm by Lincoln Cooper. A motion was made by Patricia Massey and seconded by Robert Salisbury to have L. Cooper serve as moderator.

There were no other nominations. All in favor.

The Clerk read the warning.

A motion was made by R. Salisbury and seconded by P. Massey to approve the appropriation of \$32,000.00 from the Facilities Maintenance Capital Account for the approved bid from Mark Finley, Jr. for the removal/replacement of door & windows project. L. Cooper explained that the Windows are 5 crank-style windows in the oldest section of the Municipal Building and have been in need of replacement for a number of years. They will be replaced with shorter double-hung windows, and new insulation will be added in the void, making the windows more energy efficient than what is currently in place. The door in question is an exterior door in the Recreation Director's Office. It is estimated to be from the 1960s and is in poor condition. It will be replaced with a steel door with a crash bar. P. Massey made a motion, and it was seconded by Julie Fontaine, that we move to a vote.
